

Community Evangelism Ideas

Make a point to become a regular at a place where you shop or eat. Get to know the staff, ask questions, and build relationships.

Tip generously at restaurants or coffee shops that you visit regularly.

Prayer walk as a family and pray for your neighbors as you pass each house.

Host an activity that you can invite your neighbors to participate in, for instance, a BBQ, game night, watch a sporting event, dessert and coffee night, lemonade stand (if you have young kids).

Start a group in your neighborhood centered around an activity that you enjoy. For example, start a running or cooking group or a book club.

Intentionally eat lunch with non-Christians and build relationships with them.

Get to work early so you can spend time praying for your coworkers.

Bring breakfast or extra snacks for everyone in your department at work.

Invite your coworkers and neighbors into service projects that you are already a part of.

Go out of your way to get to know the cleaning people and janitors that most people overlook.

Organize others when there is a coworker in need.

Get outside! Hang out in your front yard while kids play, go for walks around your neighborhood around the same time each day, or visit your neighborhood park with your kids frequently.

Participate in a city event.

Go Christmas caroling in your neighborhood, and invite your neighbors to join you.

Offer to babysit a neighbor's kids so they can have a date night.

Ask your local HOA if there is anything you can do to help improve the neighborhood, and then organize a way to do it.

Make extra dinner one night and deliver it to a busy neighbor.

Offer to help a neighbor complete a project.
