



Navigator Care & Coaching Guide

Use this guide as a framework for the Navigator-Group Guide meetings held twice per year. Campus Pastors may provide additional campus-specific emphasis, coaching, and equipping as needed.

Every Meeting:

1. Navigator Care
 - Ask thoughtful “-ly” questions to check in on how the leader is doing spiritually, emotionally, relationally, physically, vocationally, etc.
2. 8 Practices
 - What studies has your group completed since we last met?
 - How have those studies impacted your group?
 - What studies are you planning for the next quarter?
3. Group Health
 - Roster Review: Is your roster current? Refer to the quarterly email from Tori Lococo.
 - Spiritual Growth: Where have you seen God at work in the lives of your group members?
 - 100% Engagement: How are group members engaging in Baptism, Serve, Give, and Go?
 - Membership Status: Also listed in the quarterly roster review from Tori.
 - Sustainability: How are responsibilities shared within the group?
 - Go Ops: How has/is your group served the community?
 - Group Life Cycle: Is there room to add new people? What are the plans for group multiplication?
4. Navigator in Training
 - Who in your group is currently an NIT?
 - What is their status or progress through the coursework?
 - Are there other potential leaders emerging in your group?
5. Upcoming Events
 - Ensure Navigators and NITs are aware of upcoming huddles, retreats, church-wide or campus events and gain commitment to attend.

Annual Accountability Meeting (Feb-Mar)

- Review the Navigator Expectations (PDF) together, asking discussion questions such as:
 - What is God teaching you through Scripture right now?
 - What are you praying for regularly?
 - What does Sabbath rest look like for you?
 - How is the health of your marriage?
 - Is there anyone in your life with whom you need to reconcile, challenge, or encourage?
 - How are you using your gifts to love and serve God and people in the church, community, and world?
 - Who is on your Top 5? How are you BLESSing them?
- Review the Annual Household Giving Statement, asking the following:
 - Does your giving statement reflect at least 10% of your gross household income to CCCC’s general fund?
 - How has giving this year grown your heart for God and his mission?
 - In what ways do you see God’s provision as you faithfully give?
